In The Spotlight

Sally Lemley joined the Ski Club of Lockport (SCOL) around 1999 or 2000 and thanks Linda Fogle for the invite. Sally was 39 years old when she first skied in December of 1995, and felt that SCOL was a good way to get to know people that enjoyed the sport.

Sally says that “The camaraderie, friendships, going on the trips and skiing with various people in the club has made me a better skier. “SCOL is a great group of really good people with the common interest of skiing and having fun”.

Sally has served on the Board of Directors, has been the Recording Secretary, and ran a bus trip to Bristol Mountain in 2005, her first bus trip with the club. Sally has also organized several East Trips to various resorts in Vermont and a trip to Montreal, Canada.

Sally recalls that she’s been on so many memorable SCOL east trips that it’s difficult to pick one, but skiing at Le Massif stands out. “I had been wanting to go there for years, and we had a beautiful blue bird day with great conditions. It was everything that I had imagined it would be with beautiful views of the river as you’re skiing down the hill”.

“My first West Trip was to Sun Peaks, BC in 2004, and that’s where I got to really meet and get to know people in the club; the Snow Bar was the highlight of the trip. My first trip to Banff was in 2005, I had never experienced anything as beautiful as the Canadian Rockies. In 2006 we went to Big Sky. I had great condo-mates, but a lot of people got sick on that trip. Our condo managed to stay healthy; we credited it to Tequila and Red Wine. The skiing was also good.”

Sally reflects on her amazing trip to St. Moritz, Switzerland. “I had dreamed of going to Switzerland since I was a young girl, and the experience didn’t disappoint. Everything was great, from skiing in the Alps to all of the great activities we were able to enjoy: sledging between villages, beautiful St. Moritz and topped off with the World Cup Polo Match on the lake. I look forward to making many more great memories with the club!

Sally has “some great memories of skiing at HV, not only because of the conditions, but mostly because of the great, fun people I’ve been fortunate to meet and call friends. Bluebird spring days skiing followed by hanging out and socializing on the deck are the best”. “I enjoy the challenge of the Eagle and Chute areas, and the beauty of the Tannenbaum area.”

Sally also volunteered with the Lounsbury Adaptive Ski Program at Holiday Valley for 12 years, which also provided her with great experiences and memories of Holiday Valley.


