Ski Club of Lockport COVID-19 Policy

We continue to monitor CDC, state and municipal health guidelines. The SCOL Board has adopted these guidelines.

Based on guidelines found here ([Prevent Getting Sick | CDC](#)), Ski Club of Lockport has adopted the following policies to ensure the safety of all members. Should New York State requirements exceed CDC, SCOL events will be compliant with New York state requirements. If a venue that is hosting a SCOL event has requirements that exceed NYS or CDC, attendees will comply with those requirements. SCOL reserves the right to ask anyone in attendance to leave a SCOL sponsored event should they not comply.

- If you are fully vaccinated, to maximize protection from the Delta variant and prevent possibly spreading it to others, wear a mask indoors in public if you are in an area of substantial or high transmission.
- If you are unvaccinated or not fully vaccinated wear a mask as outlined by public health guidelines.
- If you are feeling sick or have COVID-19 symptoms please do not attend a SCOL event and stay home.
- If you test positive for COVID-19 please do not attend a SCOL event for at least 10 days from the date that your test sample was collected.
- If you have a COVID-19 test within 96 hours of a SCOL event that you attended and the test is positive please contact one of the following Board members;

- The following will occur when the board is notified by an individual that has attended a SCOL event and they have been tested for COVID-19 within 96 hours of the event and the test result is positive;
 - An email will be sent to all member's with the following:
 - Date of event and notice that we received information of a positive test result from an attendee
 - Link to CDC Guidance
 - No personal information will be disclosed

Please consider your own personal health when deciding to attend a SCOL event. Attendees may decide to do personal protection beyond current requirements and we ask all attendees to refrain from any form of harassment related to personal protection. Be respectful towards each other. SCOL would like to remind everyone about COVID protocols like social distancing and wearing a mask indoors.
